

HAPPY BIRTHDAY CAKE

PAPER CHOICE

Altough this resource may print on any type of paper thickness I would recommend a heavyweight white matte photo paper or cardstock. The resource is formatted to papersize U.S. Letter $(8.5 \times 11 \text{ inches})$ but can also print perfectly on A4 $(21.0 \times 29.7 \text{cm})$ or $8.27 \times 11.69 \text{ in})$.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. PRINT AND CUT OUT THE INDIVIDUAL INVITATIONS

Open the file in the software program **Adobe Reader.** If you don't have the program installed or need to update a previous version you can do so forfree and easy at: http://adobe.com/go/reader Print all the individual parts and cut them out.

2. FOLD AND GLUE TOGETHER

Start by folding all the tabs of the shape marked as part 1 inwards. Then fold part 1 and glue the end tab (marked with a G) so it forms a cylindrical shape. Now put glue on the tabs of the top part of the cylidrical shape and glue part 2 to the top of part 1.

TIP/OPTIONAL

Before you glue the cake to the plate/part 3 you could fill it with some samll candy or other small suprise.

Glue the tabs on the bottom of the cake and glue it to part 3, place it in the center of the white circle.

Glue the opposite sides of the tabs and backside of part 4. Lastl glue part 4 to the top of the cake. All done, now you have yourself a happy birthday cake.
